In accordance with our charter, student enrollment will be on a first-come, first-served basis beginning March 18, 2015 unless applicants exceed space available by the lottery cutoff date of April 17, 2015. Should applicants exceed space available, a lottery will be held at 3:00 p.m. April 24, 2015 in the Charter School Office located at 325 Marion Avenue room 27, Ben Lomond.

Please note that in ALL Charter Programs:

- a. Parent involvement is strongly encouraged. Such involvement is a primary focus of our programs.
- b. A written document will be required in the form of a cover letter (Nature Academy grades 6-8). Details in box below.
- c. Consideration will be given toward maintaining a balance between grade levels.
- d. Because the intimacy of a small school environment better promotes education, our total enrollment will be limited, not to exceed 26:1 ADA (average daily attendance).

In addition to the admission policies given above, applicant preference for the Nature Academy shall be given in the following order: (proof of residency may be requested)

1. To current students in the Nature Academy
2. Children of SLVUSD Charter School Teaching Staff
3. Siblings of current Nature Academy students and siblings of Nature Academy alumni. Alumni must reside in the district and attend a district school.
4. Any other students residing in the district.
5. Students who live outside of the school district.

For new students applying to the Nature Academy in grades 6-8 this application must include:
A personal letter, in ink, in applicant's handwriting, addressing the following:
Applicant's desire to attend the program
Academic interests, strengths, and weaknesses
Life Skill strengths and weaknesses – top three of each (see Life Skill sheet)
Hobbies and interests (including sports)
